



## 2011 TROT CANADA NATIONAL HANDICAPPING QUALIFYING RULES

- Players must be 18+; players must submit their own entry forms.
- Staff of The Raceway, Western Fair District, Compass employees and OLG Slots staff are not permitted to participate in this contest.
- One contest entry per person, per day.
- Entry forms available in The Raceway program on qualifying days: October 21, 22, 27 & 28, 2011.
- Entries will be accepted starting at 6 p.m. on each contest date.
- Entries must be deposited in the drum at The Raceway's Customer Service area before the beginning of Race 2 at The Raceway on each contest date.
- Scoring of selections will be based on each player's bankroll using a hypothetical \$2 win and \$2 place wager.
- The contest begins with race TWO (2) at The Raceway in the Western Fair District. Contestants must make one (1) selection in races TWO (2), THREE (3), FOUR (4), FIVE (5) SIX (6), SEVEN (7) and EIGHT (8).
- Players may also enter a scratch substitute in the event their main selection is a late scratch.
- A hypothetical \$2.00 win and \$2.00 place wager will be placed on each contestant's selection.
- Each contestant's hypothetical bankroll will be credited with the official payouts should they finish first or second.
- If a player's main selection and substitute are scratched, the player's hypothetical bankroll will be credited with \$4.00.
- Contestants will be ranked in order of their hypothetical bankroll. The contestant with the highest hypothetical bankroll will be deemed the winner. The contestant with the second highest bankroll will be the alternate winner and so on.
- In the event that two contestants have the same hypothetical bankroll after the contest is complete, the following tie breaker will be used:
  - Most winners selected
  - Most second place finishers selected
  - Highest win payout
  - Highest place payout
  - If the tie has still not been broken, then a random draw will take place to determine the winner(s)
- Unofficial results, pending an audit of the scoring, will be posted at The Raceway's Customer Service Desk at the end of each contest night.
- Qualifiers will be notified by phone within two business days and invited back for the Final on November 4, 2011.
- The top six (6) finishers in the Final will be eligible to compete in the TROT Canada National Handicapping Championship to be hosted in the Carousel Room at the Western Fair District on November 12, 2011.
- Winners must accept the prize as awarded. There will be no substitutions.
