### JOB DESCRIPTION - Paddock Lead Hand

The Paddock Lead Hand reports directly to Track Superintendent.

#### **Job description:**

The Paddock lead hand will be responsible for the day to day cleaning and maintenance of the paddock building along with the cleaning and maintenance of the paddock lot.

The paddock lead hand will assist with racetrack and infield operations at times and knowledge of Standardbred racing - along with good general fitness and ability to carry out general maintenance duties - will be assets for this position.

Must have the ability to operate heavy equipment and possess both a valid driver's license and AGCO license.

#### **Duties:**

Clean and bed horse stalls

Sweep and power wash paddock (approximately 3 hours per day)

Garbage removal

Snow removal and salting sanding door and walkways

General maintenance to the building and equipment

Assist with snow plowing of lot as required, assist with supervision of staff and assist with racetrack operations

#### **Other Responsibilities:**

- Work as a team player promoting a positive and professional work environment and conduct role with integrity and respect.
- Act as an Ambassador throughout the Community, positively representing the Western Fair District.
- Abide by the policies and procedures of Western Fair District
- Other duties as assigned in order to meet the overall goals and objectives of the Western Fair District

#### **Working Conditions**

- Ability to work flexible hours including some evenings, weekends and holidays.
